April 13: Peter and the apostles replied, 'We must obey God rather than humans!'" May we always remember that yours is the supreme authority, Adonai. We bow to no one but you. (Acts 5:29)

April 14: 11. "If their plan or activity is of human origin, it will end in ruin. If it originates with God, you won't be able to stop them." May we join you in your unstoppable work, O Christ. May we love as you love. (Acts 5:38-39)

April 15: "Praise God, all of you who are his messengers! Praise God, all of you who comprise his heavenly forces! Sun and moon, praise God! All of you bright stars, praise God!" (Psalm 148:2-3)

April 16: "You have a pure and enduring inheritance that cannot perish—an inheritance that is presently kept safe in heaven for you." Lord, we thirst for what you have in store for us. May our hunger for the Kingdom drive us into loving action. (1 Peter 1:4)

April 17: "Although you've never seen him, you love him. Even though you don't see him now, you trust him and so rejoice with a glorious joy that is too much for words." Attune our hearts to your nearness, O Christ. (1 Peter 1:8)

April 18: "We are witnesses of everything he did, both in Judea and in Jerusalem. They killed him by hanging him on a tree, but God raised him up on the third day and allowed him to be seen, not by everyone but by us. We are witnesses whom God chose beforehand." Give us eyes to see your presence, Christ. (Acts 10:39-41)

April 19: "On that same day, two disciples were traveling to a village called Emmaus... Jesus himself arrived and joined them on their journey. They were prevented from recognizing him." Reveal yourself to us, Christ. (Luke 24:13,15-16)

April 20: "Then Jesus said to them, 'You foolish people! Your dull minds keep you from believing all that the prophets talked about.'" Reveal the meaning of scripture to us, Christ. (Luke 24:25)

April 21: "When they came to Emmaus, he acted as if he was going on ahead. But they urged him, saying, 'Stay with us. It's nearly evening, and the day is almost over.' So he went in to stay with them." May we offer you hospitality, Christ. (Luke 24:28-29)

April 22: "After he took his seat at the table with them, he took the bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them." We are grateful for our daily bread. Bless it for us, Christ. (Luke 24:30)

April 23: "Their eyes were opened and they recognized him, but he disappeared from their sight." Open our hearts, Christ, so that we can see what our eyes cannot: that you remain present with us. (Luke 24:31)

April 24: "They said to each other, 'Weren't our hearts on fire when he spoke to us along the road and when he explained the scriptures for us?'" Light fires in our hearts, Christ. May we burn for your presence. (Luke 24:32)

April 25: "As you set yourselves apart by your obedience to the truth so that you might have genuine affection for your fellow believers, love each other deeply and earnestly." May we see ourselves as a people set apart from the world, O Christ. (1 Peter 1:22)

April 26: "I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out and find pasture." Guide us, good shepherd! May your love be our beacon. (John 10:9)

April 27: "They shared food with gladness and simplicity. They praised God and demonstrated God's goodness to everyone." May Earle Street Baptist Church reveal your salvation to those in our community who feel broken, risen Christ. (Acts 2:46-47)

April 28: "When he was insulted, he did not reply with insults. When he suffered, he did not threaten revenge. Instead, he entrusted himself to the one who judges justly." We entrust ourselves to you, almighty King. (1 Peter 2:23)

April 29: "Though you were like straying sheep, you have now returned to the shepherd and guardian of your lives." We gladly follow your guidance, good Shepherd. See our joy! (1 Peter 2:25)

April 30: "Yes, goodness and faithful love will pursue me all the days of my life." Pursue us, Christ! We do stray, but you will not let us get away. We stand in awe of your deep love. (Psalm 23:6)

May 1: In this beautiful month of new growth, teach me to practice new ways of trusting You.

May 2: Help me, Lord, to trust you with my whole heart, with my whole life and with my future. (Proverbs 3:5)

May 3: Let me trust you as Abraham did when you commanded him to place his son, Isaac, on the sacrificial altar. Help me to know that You will always provide. (Genesis 22:13)

May 4: Let me trust you with the people who are most precious to me knowing that you love them more than I do.

May 5: Help me trust you as Joseph did, when others treated him badly. Help me remain faithful when hurtful things happen to me. (Genesis 50:20)

May 6: Teach me to trust you more when I am treated badly by my enemies. Help me rest in the assurance that you provide good for me.

May 7: Give me the faith of Hannah, who kept her promise to God when He answered her prayers for a child. (1 Samuel 1:28)

May 8: When my prayers are answered and good things happen, teach me always to acknowledge that you are the source of all good things

May 9: Give me the trust of Jacobed, who placed her son, Moses, in a basket and in God's hands along the Nile River. (Exodus 2:3)

May 11: Let me have the conviction of Moses to say that God will fight for me in hard situations. (Exodus 14:21-22)

May 12: Instead of filling my conversation with words of fret and worry, help me to speak faith and trust in God's plan.

May 13: Remind me over and over of all the times You have been faithful to me, so that my trust in You grows daily.

May 14: Help my trust in You to be like Daniel's when he was thrown into the lion's den. (Daniel 6:23)

May 15: Lord, we all face difficult situations in our lives. Help me to trust you and not be fearful.

May 16: As Elijah trusted you to supply his needs, help me to trust you to provide mine. (1 Kings 17:15-16)

May 17: Show me, Lord, how to trust you for my needs and not confuse my wants for my needs.

May 18: Give me faith and trust like Job, who never spoke against God even in his devastating losses.

May 19: Help me to trust you, God, so that when all seems lost I can say, "Though he slay me, yet will I still trust him." (Job 13:15)

May 20: Like Paul and Silas in prison, help me sing your praises even in difficulty. (Acts 16:25)

May 21: Help my words be words of confidence in your plan, rather than words of fear and doubt.

May 22: When responsibilities of life are heavy, help me trust in you as Deborah did when she led Israel. (Judges 5:7)

May 23: Our duties at home, at work or at church may seem burdensome. Help us trust you to equip us to do your will.

May 24: Like Isaiah, help me to trust you when I am disappointed and discouraged. (Isaiah 49:3-4)

May 25: Help me trust you for courage when it would be easy to give up and quit.

May 26 Lord, please put people in my life who encourage me to trust you more, in every situation.

May 27: Help me, Lord, to be the encourager who spurs those in my sphere to trust you more every day.

May 28: Thank you, Lord Jesus, that you are worthy of our trust all the time and whatever our circumstances.

May 29: Help me, Lord, to put my trust in you as John Sammis wrote in 1887, "Trust and Obey, for there's no other way to be happy in Jesus, but to trust and obey."
